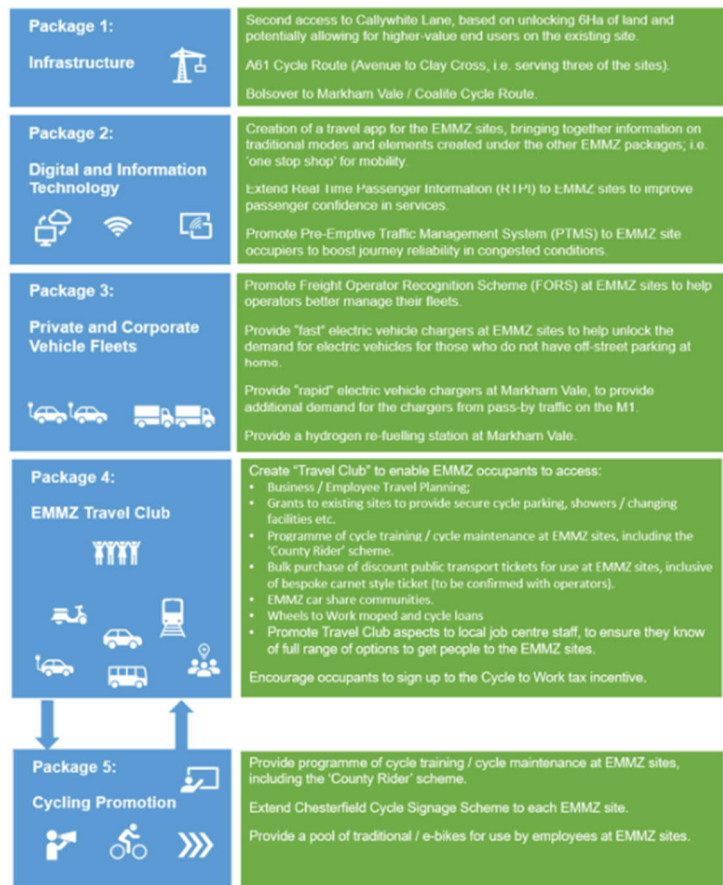

<b>Brief Project Description</b> (300 Characters)	<p>Derbyshire County Council (DCC) commissioned AECOM on behalf of a wider partnership (including D2N2, Bolsover District Council, Chesterfield Borough Council and North East Derbyshire District Council) to prepare a Mobility Strategy to support the Northern Derbyshire East Midlands Manufacturing Zone (EMMZ) proposals.</p> <p>A series of potential mobility packages were identified, and an overall Strategic Outline Business Case (SOBC) was prepared to support future funding bids.</p>
<b>Full Project Description</b>	<p>The EMMZ was created by Government to accelerate development of employment land. Within Northern Derbyshire, this work is centred on existing sites of manufacturing (Callywhite Lane, Markham Vale, Coney Green) and several planned manufacturing sites (The Avenue, Clowne Garden Village, Staveley and Rother Regeneration Corridor, Coalite and Egstow Park).</p> <p>The Mobility Strategy examined the existing and potential future modes of transport available to employees, as well as the infrastructure available for commercial movements (including the movement of raw materials and finished goods), before identifying options to improve mobility.</p> <p>The work included full walking and cycling audits around each site, as a wider objective was to maximise accessibility of opportunity to local people by removing immediate barriers to employment and training.</p> <p>Following the identification of a 'long list' of options, stakeholder workshops were used to sift the options to five core packages of measures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Package 1: Infrastructure;</li> <li>• Package 2: Digital and Information Technology;</li> <li>• Package 3: Corporate and Private Fleets;</li> <li>• Package 4: EMMZ Travel Club; and</li> </ul>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Package 5: Cycling.</li> </ul> <p>The Mobility Strategy contained both an implementation plan and a monitoring framework. A Strategic Outline Business Case (SOBC) has also been prepared to support the Mobility Strategy.</p>
