Supporting Local Community Projects and Charities

Flannery's Danaher & Walsh and Balfour Beatty – Putney Road Project

Objectives: To support a local primary school and the pupils in the community.

Key achievements: Raised planter installed, Disability access ramps installed, Mud kitchen constructed.

Racetrack for scooters, Hopscotch, and new equipment for the children to play with.

Looking to the future: In addition to the school playground, the furniture was purchased by the project, by the client, Leicester City Council. This has been donated to the school (Tables, Chairs, Pedestals), along with white goods and an AED, suitable for Children.

Contract Value: £6m

Finances: £5,000

Back in October 2021, Balfour Beatty engaged with Braunstone Firth Primary school to support with creating an exciting new playground for the primary school pupils. Playgrounds encourage positive health and wellbeing amongst children, stimulating fun ways to exercise and inspiring independence.

Flannery's, Danaher & Walsh, and Balfour Beatty have been dedicating time to work with Braunstone Firth Primary School, which is in an under privileged area of Leicester. The redevelopment has now been successfully



completed, providing pupils the opportunity to learn through different types of outdoor play and activity.

Home to around 600 pupils, the school now offers, as of 29 July 2022, a fantastic new playground which can be utilised throughout the year, allowing children to enjoy their breaks outside in the fresh air. One child, with cerebral palsy, has said how great it is that she can now leave with all her friends, via the classroom door, meeting her mum at the parent pick-up point at the end of the day, thanks to the new disability ramps installed. The redevelopment that BB and Flannery's have completed hasn't just provided a fun space for pupils, it's provided an inclusive one.
