Brief Project Description (300 Characters)	Provide bespoke support for graduates in their specific roles for Lee Turner's team at Oxfordshire County Council (CC). Through Waterman Aspen's Regional Training Manager's use of contacts and sharing recommendations this support was opened out more widely to Oxfordshire CC colleagues.
Full Project Description	Following multiple requests, from Waterman Aspen staff in the East Midlands, for Civil 3D training, inquiries were made with a training provider who were able to hold in-person training within the East Midlands. A 3-day course was arranged in late November/December 2022, with spaces being offered to clients from Leicestershire County Council and Derby City Council. The training was successful for the delegates who took part, with positive feedback from the local authority partners who attended. The intention is to hold a second event in early 2023 again with spaces being offered to local authority clients.

Lean Delivery/ Efficiency Savings	There is a need for Civil 3D support within these authorities and instead of full reliance on external support staff through the MHA, we continue to support with the upskilling of the local authority staff to enable their own dependence with this software, which includes our continued support from our own Civil 3D champions.
