
We are delighted to have once again provided our support for the Melton Aurora Rotary Club Santa Sleigh collection 2024.



We were delighted to welcome local student Tyler to the project to assist him with his future aspirations of becoming a civil engineer.

Tyler spent his first week with us during his half term break and will return during summer to continue with his training.

#### Tyler said:

I wanted to say a massive thanks to Galliford Try and the MMDR project team for their support during my work experience placement.

I really enjoyed my first week at the Melton Mowbray bypass project, I spent my work experience with the site engineers which is a role I am very interested in and would like to pursue further.

It has been very useful for me to see the project in person giving me the opportunity to have some hands-on experience and insight into the various skills and duties of a Site Engineer.

During my time with the site engineers, I have learnt and practiced a wide range of skills, including using high tech GPS equipment and laser levels for measuring drainage systems along with understanding and using drawings and plans to highlight the location of the dig.

The highlight of the week was being involved in the supervising of the pouring of concrete for one the bridges on the project, part of my role was calculating the volume of the concrete that is needed, quality checking of as the slump and using clear documentation to record this.

Meeting members of the team has been insightful and everyone I have worked with has been informative about the job role and approachable when I have wanted to ask questions, I have appreciated the time everyone has taken to support me in my placement.

This experience has really helped me understand what I will look for in my next step after finishing secondary school. I have found that working in construction is definitely the path that I am wanting to pursue. I look forward to returning to the project in the summer to continue my work experience.

Having received a request from the Melton & District Indoor Bowls Club(M&DIBC) to ask if we could offer advice and support for their ambitious outdoor landscaping project we agreed to help.

With the support of our NEMMDR landscaping contractor ATV and Collins Earthworks we have provided expert advice, materials and knowledge to support "The Pheonix Project" and help get it moving in the right direction.







Chris Fleckney, Director M&DIBC, said: Melton and District Indoor Bowls Club Ltd (M&DIBC) wishes to express its gratitude and thanks to Galliford Try Infrastructure, ATV Contract Services and Collins Earthworks for the assistance they have given to the Phoenix Project over the last 3 months.

The Phoenix Project involves the rewilding of the 2 unused, outdoor bowls greens. The ongoing work involves planting over 240 trees and landscaping the area to encourage wildlife. The site regularly floods and the rationale behind the project is to enable the newly planted area to act as a flood mitigation measure by absorbing water.

Galliford Try and Collins Earthworks have already donated and transported topsoil needed for our project. ATV has provided both landscaping advice and practical support to restructure the area from being a uniform flat surface into one with dips and mounds, forming a more natural wooded area and wildflower meadow.
