This event is **free for MHA members** and will be held at Markham Vale Environment Centre, Markham Lan, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S44 5HY

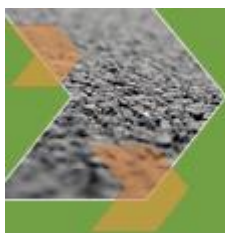
