Closer to home, the Carillion/Tarmac Joint Venture has been part of both the Medium Schemes Framework 1 and 2 and Carillion's collapse could have easily had a major impact on many schemes.

However, through MSF2, the provisions of the agreement provided for Tarmac to continue the work of the Joint Venture.

Thanks to Tarmac's hard work, we are pleased to report that work on both the A50 Growth Corridor at Uttoxeter and the FARRRS Phase 2 development for Doncaster have continued with only minimal delay.

Planned learning, training and development programme for 18/19


