

HTMA - road space utilisation tool

Over the years we have worked on several projects with the Highway Term Maintenance Association (HTMA). Their latest project is a 'road space utilisation tool'.

This has been developed on an Excel spreadsheet format and takes four main stakeholder standards into account: value for money, safety, environment and public perception, when identifying the best option for carrying out works (e.g. road closure/night working/traffic control).

HTMA is keen to trial the tool and would welcome comments from local highway authorities on its usefulness.

It has been presented to the Term Community Board and seems very useful.
