

NEC3 and NEC4 compared training workshop

On November 29, the MHA hosted the NEC3 and NEC4 compared – the first learning event of its kind provided by the MHA – at the NSPCC National Training Centre in Leicester.



The fully booked session with 20 participants was delivered by Rob Gerrard, a member of the group drafting NEC contracts and author of books on NEC2, NEC3 as well as NEC4.

It was free for those MHA members in attendance, and gave them the opportunity to learn more about NEC4 – while summarising the changes for existing users.

Feedback on the day included: Provided relevant scenarios / good examples of answers to attendees' questions; Instructor had a good knowledge of the subject; It was good that the presenter tailored the event on the day to what people wanted to know; Well presented, good handouts, good information.



The NEC4 has taken the successful NEC3 contract suite and enhanced it, with some new features and some new forms of contract. All of the changes are a direct result of feedback from industry, to support methods and provide solutions which clients are demanding.

The session had the objective of helping those who work with any of the NEC contracts and future sessions are planned throughout 2018, with the next one set to take place on February 28 at Kents Hill Park Training & Conference Centre in Milton Keynes.
